

Oklahoma Case Law

♦ *Jackson v. State*, 2006 OK CR 45, 146 P.3d 1149 (2006): Defendant's custodial statements directing police to a child's location fell under the rescue exception to *Miranda* because: 1) after discovering the victim's body, police learned that she had a child who was missing; 2) the child was not with defendant when he was apprehended and the police reasonably feared for his safety; 3) defendant was the last person known to be with the child; 4) police had unsuccessfully searched the surrounding area for the child and interviewed friends and family; and 5) their questions were limited to the child's location.
